SUBJECT: BOLIVIAN GOVERNMENT CANCELS HMONG RESETTLEMENT AGREEMENT

1. ON OCTOBER 30 THE FOREIGN MINISTRY UNEXPECTEDLY ISSUED A DECREE VOIDING PREVIOUS GOVERNMENT'S AGREEMENT WITH FOOD FOR THE HUNGRY INTERNATIONAL (FHI) CONCERNING THE RESETTLEMENT OF AN UNSPECIFIED NUMBER OF HMONG REFUGEES IN BOLIVIA. THE FOREIGN MINISTRY'S DECISION FOLLOWED CLOSELY A PUBLIC DENUNCIATION OF THE PROJECT BY THE LEFTIST MIR PARTY, WHICH CLAIMED THAT THE AGREEMENT WITH FHI SUBORDINATED BOLIVIA'S NATIONAL INTERESTS TO THOSE OF "IMPERIALISM."

2. THE MIR STATEMENT, WHICH WAS REPORTED IN THE PRESS ON OCTOBER 30, REFERRED TO CORRESPONDENCE BETWEEN FORMER IMMIGRATION SUBLIMITED OFFICIAL USE

SECRETARY GUIDO STRAUSS AND FORMER FOREIGN MINISTRY UNDER SECRETARY MARCELO TERCEROS BANZER RELATING TO THE IMMIGRATION OF UP TO 40,000 (SIC) LAOTIAN REFUGEES. THE MIR DID NOT OPPOSE IN THE PRINCIPLE THE IDEA OF REFUGE RESETTLEMENT IN BOLIVIA, BUT RATHER THE SECRETIVE NATURE OF THE NEGOTIATIONS WITH FHI AND THE FACT (WHICH WE CAN NOT SUBSTANTIATE) THAT LAND SUCH AS THAAT SET ASIDE FOR THE HMONGS HAS NOT BEEN MADE

AVAILABLE TO LOCAL COLONIZERS. REFERRING OBLIQUELY TO THE MIR STATEMENT, THE FOREIGN MINISTRY DECLARED THE FHI AGREEMENT "INVALID"BECAUSE OF "CONCEPTUAL FAUTLS".

3. IN A CONVERSATION WITH EMBASSY OFFICER ON NOVEMBER 2, IMMIGRATION SUB-SECRETARY LUDWIG ALVES COMPALINED THATHIS PREDECESSOR STRAUSS, WHO IS NOT FHI'S AGENT IN BOLIVIA, HAD INTERPOSED HIMSELF BETWEEN ALVES AND FHI PRESIDENT WARD, THUS IMPEDING THE RATIFICATION PROCESS. HE MAINTAINND, HOWEVER, THAT THE AGREEMENT MIGHT STILL BE SAVED IF HE WERE ABLE TO MEET DIRECTLY WITH WARD OR FHI LATIN AMERICAN DIRECTOR DEAN FLLORA.

4. COMMENT: WE HAVE INFORMED FLORA OF THE FOREGOING DEVELOP-MENTS BY TELEPHONE. HE AND POSSIBLY WARD WILL RETURN TO BOLIVIA EARLY NEXT WEEK TO TRY TO RESURRECT THE AGREEMENT. OF COURSE, WE WILL CONTINUE TO PROVIDE SUCH ASSISTANCE AS MAY BE APPROPRIATE. HOWEVER, WE ARE NOT CONFIDENT THAT A RENEWED FHI INITIATIVE WILL BE SUCCESSFUL NOW THAT THE HMONG PROJECT HAS SUDDENTLY BECOME A CONTROVERSIAL DOMESTIC POLITICAL ISSUE. BOEKER
